Mother pigs are confined to gestation crates for the duration of their pregnancy.

Gestation crates cause physical suffering. As female pigs expand in pregnancy, crates press more and more against their bodies, causing discomfort, lesions or pressure sores, and rectal prolapse. Pigs develop urinary-tract infections because the unnatural "dog-sitting position" that crates require "helps to force (their own) fecal material into the(ir) vagina(s)."
